## DIRECTIONS TO THE GREEN QUAD

The mission of USC's **Green (West) Quad** is to create a living and learning community which integrates sustainability into all aspects of its operations. It serves as a model and advocate for sustainability on campus and in the larger community. **The Learning Center for Sustainable Futures** promotes collaborative relationships among students, faculty, staff, and community members for exploring the changes required to create a sustainable society.

The Learning Center is a one-story building in the middle of the Green Quad. The Quad is **located** south of Wheat Street, between Main and Sumter. There is a walkway through the middle of the Quad running between Main and Sumter, and the entrance to the Learning Center is off the walkway among four palmetto trees.

**Parking** is most easily available on the top level of the Sumter Street Parking Garage (as you drive down the hill on Sumter, from Blossom toward Wheat, take the first driveway on your right). Some parking is also available along Sumter and Main Streets. Two university parking lots sit nearby, one on Main between Blossom and Wheat, and the other is off Sumter Street, further down the hill (south) past the overhead bridge.
